# Official Development Assistance (ODA)

#### Some issues of ODA:

- ODA induces transfer of money in national budgets (Collier & Hoeffler, 2007).
- Dependency of target organizations on ODA (Heyneman & Lee, 2016) and their low capacities.
- Implementation of non-indigenous knowledge (Breidlid, 2009).

#### Market and government failure theories:

 Important role of private philanthropy and NPOs as stakeholders.



#### **Research Questions**

- Do the problems of ODA apply also in richer countries?
- How does the international assistance influence local NPOs?
- Do the NPOs have sufficient capacities to achieve their missions?



# The NPOs' capacities in the Czech Republic

- The Czech Republic belongs among the richer countries: It stands at the place 40 of 189 countries (Gregson, 2017)
- Vast inflow of external funding from the EU
- Financial capacities as the crucial condition for the NPOs' activities.
- NPOs' got about 3.4% of the EU funds allocation (0.56 of 16.7 billion EUR)
- Success rate of NPOs of 31.7% means "wasted effort" on more than 6,000 applications (HOPE-E.S., 2012; MRD, 2014).



- JUSTICE.CZ records about Public Beneficial Corporations (PBCs) financial statements (financial variables, age)
- Database Albertina (region, specialization CZ-COPNI including education)
- CEDR III, Monit7+ (subsidies and EU funds support)

## **Propensity score matching**

- Region (three main regions);
- Year when a PBO was established (year);
- Support in the period 2004-06 (1/0);
- Assets in 2007 (in CZK);
- Revenues in 2007 (in CZK).





## **Estimation of the impact**

#### **Financial development of PBCs**





Source: Own elaboration based on the data from justice.cz; All values are in thousands CZK



- Lower revenues in comparison group: skills of managers; project class oriented to EU funding.
- Dependence on actual economic situation in the country: Economic downturn in 2008, 2009, and 2013 caused decreased revenues in PBCs.
- Dependence of the supported PBCs on EU funding: Changes in funding available are projected in revenues of these PBCs.
- Stable assets in PBCs. They are neither
   increasing nor decreasing.



- The problems and principles of ODA in lowincome countries are very similar with these in a developed country.
- No significant effect on long-term financial capacities, but on short-term viability.
- Building long-term capacities would enable increase efficiency of the ODA and private philanthropy.
