

Philanthropy in Childhood Education in China: Trends and Perspectives

Introduction

China is becoming an increasingly important key actor in philanthropy in education. This event will target foundations, non-profit educational organizations, academia, business, social enterprises, media and government to discuss the theme of education equity and innovation in childhood education in China. The event will bring together around 160 participants and high-level speakers presenting a combination of domestic and international experiences and case studies.
