Dr. Sajid Ali is the Amir Sultan Chinoy Associate Professor at the Aga Khan University's Institute for Educational Development, Pakistan. He has published widely on issues relating to globalisation and education policy, educational governance, and policymaking in Pakistan and the region. His work has been featured in outlets such as Globalisation, Societies and Education and Improving Schools, and he has an upcoming co-edited volume from Oxford University Press, entitled Reforming Education in Pakistan: achievements, challenges and lessons learnt. He has worked with governments and development agencies to shape educational policies in Pakistan, such as national Teacher Licensing Policy. Dr. Ali holds a PhD in Education Policy Studies from the University of Edinburgh (UK), an MEd in Leadership and Policy from Monash University (Australia), and a Masters in Sociology from the University of Karachi (Pakistan).
